SCHEDULING ORDER

This capital habeas corpus case came on for scheduling conference by telephone at 9:10 a.m. on Monday, November 17, 2003. [NAME] and [NAME] participated on behalf of the Petitioner; [NAME] and [NAME] participated on behalf of Respondent.

Petitioner shall file his Petition forthwith. The original Petition must be filed in paper form with the original ink signature of the Petitioner, along with a .pdf copy, at the Clerk's Office in Cincinnati. All further filings in this case shall be made at the Dayton location of court. The Court strongly encourages all counsel in the case to register for electronic filing and to file as much as possible in the case electronically. To the maximum extent possible, documents should be filed in distilled .pdf format, rather than scanned, so that they are searchable and to minimize space consumption.

The Return of Writ shall be filed January 20, 2004, without further order of the Court under Rule 4 of the Rules Governing §2254 Cases.

The Traverse shall be filed not later than April 1, 2004.

Petitioner must file any request for discovery not later than May 1, 2004, although the parties are encouraged to engage in agreed-upon discovery prior to that date.

Petitioner must file any request for evidentiary hearing not later than thirty days after a ruling by the Court on requested discovery.
