ORDER

In contemplation of petitioner’s counsel traveling in connection with representation of the petitioner, counsel are ADVISED that they may qualify for government rates on airline tickets, lodging and rental cars. When appropriate, an Order will be issued authorizing the travel, and specifically, the number and identity of counsel permitted to travel. The Order will provide information to counsel about how to arrange the travel.
