ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS REQUESTING USE OF JUROR QUESTIONNAIRE  
AND SETTING DEADLINE FOR AGREED DESCRIPTION OF CASE

Pending before the Court is defendant \_\_\_\_\_'s Motion Requesting Use of Juror Questionnaire, which was filed in the above-styled and numbered cause on June 30, 1995. Also pending before the Court is the government's Motion and Brief Requesting That the Attached Questionnaire be Distributed to the Jury Panel, which was filed in the above-styled and numbered cause on April 10, 1995. After careful consideration of the motions, the Court finds that they should be and are hereby GRANTED.<sup>1</sup> Furthermore, the Court has reviewed the proposed questionnaire submitted by the parties and has made certain modifications thereto. The questionnaire, as modified by the Court, is attached as an exhibit to this order. Any objections, modifications, or proposed additions to this questionnaire shall be made in writing no later than 4:30 p.m. on August 2, 1995.

Furthermore, the Court finds that, in order to fully and completely answer the questions posed on any juror questionnaire, the prospective jury members must be

provided with a brief description of the nature of the case and the penalty being sought by the government. Consequently, counsel for the parties are hereby ORDERED to confer in an attempt to reach agreement regarding a description of the case to be provided to prospective jury members immediately prior to distribution of the juror questionnaire. Counsel for the parties shall file an original and one copy of their agreed description of the case with the clerk of the court no later than 4:30 p.m. on August 2, 1995.
