If you need extra space to answer any question, please use the extra blank sheets of paper included at the end of the questionnaire. Be sure to indicate on the blank page the number of the question you are answering. If there is a question the answer to which you would prefer to give the Court in private, please indicate that on the questionnaire in the space following the question by writing, "I wish to discuss answer with Judge." Please write or print legibly using a black pen. If your answers are illegible, you may be required to re-copy your answers. <u>Do not write on the back of any page</u>.
