ORDER DIRECTING RETURN OF MINOR CHILDREN TO COUNTRY OF HABITUAL RESIDENCE

The Court orders, pursuant to the 1980 Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction (the "Hague Convention") and the International Child Abduction Remedies Act, 22 U.S.C. §§ 9001 et. seq. and with the consent of both parties as evidenced by the signatures of their counsel, that ______ (the "minor child"), whose date of birth is ______, be returned in the company of _______, to the sovereign nation of _______, be returned in the Corder of this Court is made under the authority of 22 U.S.C. § 9003(a), conferring jurisdiction upon this Court.

The details for the child's return shall be set by separate order.

The parties agree that they will incorporate the following provisions (paragraphs a through f, below) into a separate agreement and shall present the agreement to the <u>[court</u> of habitual residence] for approval:

a.
