Of course, we will see that the provision to which you object does not continue to be classified as noncontroversial and that it is not included in any legislative recommendation of the Conference, pending further study.

When the Executive Committee was told that items from the Federal Courts Study Committee might go into Title III, we suggested about twenty for the Administrative Office staff to discuss with the Senate Judiciary Committee staff. This item was one. The Executive Committee was unaware of the position your Council had taken.

By a copy of this letter I am requesting Director Mecham, the secretary of the Conference, to give you notice of any future consideration of this matter.
