NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Effective April 15, 1997, the attached Local Civil Rules and Local Admiralty and Maritime Rules shall be, and hereby are, adopted as local rules of this Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 83(a)(1).
- 2. Effective April 15, 1997, the attached Local Criminal Rules shall be, and hereby are, adopted as local rules of this Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 57(a)(1).
- 3. Effective April 15, 1997, the Local General Rules, Civil Rules, Criminal Rules, Rules for Admiralty and Maritime Claims, and Rules for Proceedings Before Magistrate Judges, and the Standing Orders of the Court on Effective Discovery in Civil Cases, currently in effect in this District shall be, and hereby are, repealed.

4. The foregoing amendments to the local rules of this Court shall take effect on April 15, 1997, and shall govern all proceedings in cases thereafter commenced and, insofar as just and practicable, all proceedings in cases then pending.
