ADVISORY GROUP STATISTICS REPORT**

**AS OF JUNE 30, 1993**

During the period January 1, 1992 to December 31, 1992 total of 7,430 cases were filed by case management track. A total of 378 (or 5%) of the cases were habeas corpus case management track, 110 (or 1%) were social security case management track, 912 (or 12%) were arbitration case management track, 426 (or 6%) were asbestos case management track, 503 (or 7%) were special case management track and 5,101 (or 69%) were standard case management track. Of the total 7,430 cases, 5,715 (or 77%) of the cases have been terminated resulting in 1,715 (or 23%) pending cases as of June 30, 1993.

Of the 5,715 cases terminated as of June 30, 1993, 344 (or 6.0%) were habeas corpus cases, 77 (or 1.2%) were social security cases, 766 (or 13.9%) were arbitration cases, 15 (or .3%) were asbestos cases, 319 (or 5.9%) were special management cases and 4,194 (or 72.7%) were standard management cases.

The entire caseload for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania has reduced from 10,560 pending civil cases as of December 31, 1991 to 8,401 pending civil cases of June 30, 1993. Non-asbestos pending cases have reduced from 4,959 as of December 31, 1991 to 4,312 as of June 30, 1993. Asbestos pending cases have reduced from 5,601 as of December 31, 1991 to 4,089 as of June 30, 1993. The reduction in the asbestos pending cases is due

to the extraordinary efforts of the Honorable Charles R. Weiner in closing 2,022 cases involved in MultiDistrict Litigation No. 875, In Re: Asbestos Litigation. Also, the majority of the cases terminated by Judge Weiner were cases pending three years or more.

Of the 5,715 cases filed from January 1, 1992 to December 31, 1992 and terminated as of June 30, 1993, a total of 3,232 (or 56.55%) were settled, 475 (or 8.31%) were terminated on motions before trial, 378 (or 6.62%) were default judgments, 419 (or 7.33%) were voluntarily dismissed, 265 (or 4.64%) were transferred to another court, 207 (or 3.62%) were remanded to another court or agency, 23 (or .40%) were terminated by an award of arbitration, 55 (or .96%) were dismissed for want of prosecution, 67 (or 1.17%) were terminated by judgment on consent, 65 (or 1.14%) were dismissed for lack of jurisdiction, 149 (or 2.61%) were statistically closed or placed in suspense, 262 (or 4.59%) were dismissed, 69 (or 1.20%) were closed by orders entering a judgment and 49 (or .86%) were closed by a jury verdict.

Of the 5,715 cases terminated as of June 30, 1993, the median time frame from filing to disposition was 115 days. The median time frame for each case management track was 114 days for standard case management track, 92 days for special case management track, 91 days for habeas corpus case management track, 79 days for asbestos case management track, 151 days for arbitration case management track and 195 days for social security case management track.

As of June 30, 1993 this district reported under the requirements of the Civil Justice Reform Act (CJRA) of 1990, 24 Motions Pending Over 180 Days, 0 bench trials

submitted over 6 months and 81 non-asbestos cases pending three years or more. As of December 31, 1991, there were a total of 249 motions pending over 6 months, 3 bench trials submitted over 6 months and 101 civil cases pending three years or more.

A total of 1,725 cases filed during calendar year 1992 have scheduling orders setting trial dates. A total of 647 (or 38%) of the cases had a trial date set 90 days after the filing date. Of the 1,725 cases with trial date settings, 1,520 (or 88.1%) are standard case management cases, 105 (or 6.1%) are special case management track, and 99 (or 5.8%) are arbitration track management cases.




