GENERAL ORDER

By direction of the full Court met in executive session on Thursday, 19 January 1995, a proposal to amend section D of Rule 2.21 of the General Rules of this Court by adding a new subsection (9) was published for comment and notice of the proposal and the availability of the text were published in the *Chicago Daily Law Bulletin*. No comments were received regarding the proposal.

The Advisory Committee on Rules and Procedures considered the proposal and the comments at its meeting on Tuesday, 9 May 1995. In its report on the proposal the Committee recommended the adoption of the proposal as published. The full Court considered the recommendation of the Advisory Committee at its meeting of 22 June 1995 and agreed to adopt the proposal as published. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That section D of Rule 2.21 of the General Rules of this Court is amended by adding the following as subsection (9):


(9) *Criminal cases where pre-indictment assignment made*

Where a proceeding arising out of a criminal complaint is required to be heard by a district judge and is assigned by lot to a district judge prior to the filing of the indictment or information associated with the complaint, the indictment or information shall be assigned directly to the calendar of the judge to whom the proceeding was assigned. Where the indictment would have been assigned using a category different from the one used to assign the criminal complaint, appropriate equalization will be made.
