

ORDER NO. 1

Pursuant to Title 1 of Public Law 101-650, the "Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990" the court hereby establishes an Advisory Group for the District of Minnesota consisting of the following:

9 -- Attorneys

These members will be selected by the Chief Judge after consultation with the other judges and will serve for staggered terms. The original attorney membership will be chosen from the current membership of the Federal Practice Committee. Efforts will be made to maintain an appropriate representation to insure that each of the major categories of litigants in the District are represented. An attempt will be made to include attorneys who represent federal, state, and local governments in the District, attorneys practicing in law firms of diverse size, in corporations, and in public interests groups representing litigants within the district.

3 -- Lay Members

Selected by the Chief Judge after consultation with the other judges to serve for staggered three year terms.

1 -- U. S. Attorney or
his/her designee

Mandated by the statute.

13 voting members of the Committee


