The Advisory Group has completed its findings and submitted its final report to the court on November 21, 1991 (attached hereto as Appendix 1). The court and the Advisory Group have reviewed and considered all of the measures as set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 473. Having read and considered the recommendations contained therein, the court hereby adopts said final report in its entirety, including the recommended measures, rules and programs in the proposed 16 point Civil Justice Expense and Delay Reduction Plan. Inasmuch as the court intends to be an early implementation district (EID),
