ORDER APPOINTING THE HONORABLE
GREGG. W. ZIVE MEDIATOR AND OTHER
SCHEDULING MATTERS PERTAINING TO
MEDIATION

A continued status conference on the Chapter 9 proceeding of the City of San Bernardino was held on September 4, 2013, before the Honorable Meredith A. Jury, to discuss appointment of a mediator to assist in plan of adjustment negotiation and other issues. After discussion on the record, the court

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Effective upon entry of this Order, The Honorable Gregg W. Zive is hereby appointed as a mediator in this chapter 9 case ("the Mediator").
2. The scope of the mediation shall be broad, including all aspects of negotiation of a plan of adjustment and any other issues submitted jointly by parties to the Mediator which pertain to Chapter 9 issues, with the exception of discovery disputes unless the Court issues an order that a specific discovery dispute should be mediated.

1 3. In preparation for the mediation the City of San Bernardino shall prepare and circulate
2 among interested parties, including the Mediator, (but not file with the Court) a Plan Term Sheet
3 by no later than October 15, 2013.


4 4. In preparation for the mediation, the attorney for the City of San Bernardino is appointed
5 by the Court as the "point person" to coordinate a pre-mediation conference with the Mediator and
6 other parties to discuss procedural aspects of the mediation. Although not a court-set deadline,
7 preferably this pre-mediation conference will be conducted prior to October 15, 2013.

8 5. This Order specifically authorizes the Mediator to issue any order or statement to the
9 mediating parties, setting forth requirements he may impose for the conduct of mediation sessions,
10 including delivery of mediation briefs or statements, requiring persons with authority to attend the
11 sessions, or any other requirements that the Mediator believes will assist him in the mediation
12 process.

13 6. The Court retains jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to
14 this order.
